


13 June 2024 the European Council adopted the EU Parliament first reading position on the proposal for the revision of the TEN-T Regulation as the legislative measure ...















Road connection
Maritime transport corridor



# The future of European competitiveness, The Draghi report", three transformations:


- 1. The need to accelerate innovation and find new growth engines

## **ROUTING OPTIMIZATION FOR A GREENER TRANSPORT**

Koper vs Hamburg by sea.

Comparison of CO2 emissions: transport of one 40' container (20 tons) from Port Said











- 27,1 km total length
- 75% (20,5km) inside 7 tunnels
- 430 m altitude difference
- Construction works started in May 2021
- Expected completion of new track end of 2025, to become operative in January 2026




