

2021-2027 Cohesion Policy allocations to biodiversity






Revision of EUSAIR: state of play and main points of discussion

- Input papers almost finalised
- Main points of discussion:
 - Social Dimension in the EUSAIR: Introduction of the 5th Pillar
 - Continental (green) component
 - Enlargement: new key cross-cutting topic
 - Other new cross-cutting topics: skills, youth, digitalisation, circular economy, smart specialisation, capacity building








IPA Adrion & EUSAIR MRS facilitating the Enlargement process of the Western Balkan

- A regional dimension that reconnects the WB to the EU;
- A horizontal cooperation based on equal footing;
- A convergence of interests on the enlargement between EU member and IPA countries;
- A capacity building effect;
- An emphasis on the relevance of territorial cooperation and cohesion;
- An inclusive approach towards stakeholders with participatory processes (consultation, engagement and mobilisation).



EUSAIR expected achievements and value

Key Achievements

- Increase in cooperation capacity (generation of joint actions/policy)
- Increase in dialogue
- Bringing actors together
 - Across countries and sectors
 - Across levels comes with maturity (time) and capacity
- Cooperation with the EC is a sign of maturity.

Added-value

- Cooperation brings legitimacy to the work - key added value.
- Working with issue on a transnational basis can increase awareness and attention (nationally).
- Facilitate synergies across sectors (closely linked with policy dialogue).



Why is EUSAIR so needed?

- 1. The EUSAIR is <u>strategic</u>, <u>political</u>, <u>not</u> <u>bureaucratic</u> (through the 3 NOs rule) and <u>reversible</u>:
 - It allows a **sector by sector integration** (currently mainly in the areas of environment, climate change, connectivity, energy, transport and innovation).
 - It is built on participatory approaches which bring together different perspectives in scoping and approaching the challenge, and work both by on the level of policy and that of action on the ground.
 - Finding and financing common solutions require aligning different funding sources, too – another reason to bring together various partners with access to funding, on national, regional levels. -> Embedding process is critical.



Why is EUSAIR so needed?

2. The revised approach we suggest through EUSAIR would strengthen the much-needed <u>feeling of ownership of the process</u>, <u>of acceptance and equality</u>, the lack of which is the strongest argument of anti-EU forces in the IPA countries.
