

Slovenian Healthcare System: Challenges, Reforms, and the Patient's Perspective

Friday, 13 February 2026, from 10:00 – 14:15

In the Hall of the National Council of the Republic of Slovenia

The Slovenian healthcare system is facing increasing pressures on its organization, financing, and accessibility during a period of significant demographic, technological, and social changes. Discussion about healthcare reforms is therefore not merely a professional issue but a key societal challenge that requires a comprehensive perspective, cross-sector dialogue, and a focus on patients' needs. The aim of the consultation is to provide a thorough overview of the functioning of the Slovenian healthcare system from the perspective of policymakers, financiers, healthcare service providers, economists, and – crucially – patients. Special emphasis will be placed on analyzing previous reform steps, the financial sustainability of the system, comparisons with European practices, and finding concrete, feasible solutions for greater efficiency and long-term stability of the system.
