Ideas for collaboration

- Often an inter-disciplinary approach is key to the success of EC programme funded projects
- A higher degree of specialization makes it more difficult for researchers to find a common language
- My contribution is to bring a common scientific perspective by designing tailored methodologies to answer meaningful research questions in the SSH
 - Eg. effects of virtual reality technologies on individuals with high functioning autism
 - Educators, engineers, linguists, parents, psychologists, experts on autism
 - Eg. Make FAIR dataset including 30 years of interviews (structured and semi-structured)
