- 3,4 km of operative quays






Hinterland rail & road connections






Maritime throughput history







Leading container terminal in North Adriatic

Year 2017 (estimated percentage of full/stuf+strip containers throughput)







Projects to increase capacities (quick wins / mid-term / long-term):

- NAPADRAG (TEN-T) => dredging Basin I 15 m (works)
- NAPAPROG (TEN-T) => project documentation for extension Pier I (studies)
- NAPASTUDIES (TEN-T) => project documentation for railway tracks on the ter and navigability study (studies)
- NAPA4CORE (CEF) => port infrastructure up-grades, railway and last mile connection, Pier I extension (works)
- FFC (CEF) => small scale supporting infrastructure and equipment
- RCMS (H2020) => possibility for a new technology and terminal facilities concept
- EIB loans => dredging port accesses and berth 7C
- Republic of Slovenia Maritime Administration (Cohesion fund) => dredging accessing channel to Basin I 15 m (works)



New projects' priorities

- **Infrastructure:** New capacities for strategic cargo groups: containers and cars + Improved port's accessibility and connectivity, overcoming bottlenecks
- **Smart Contents:** Environment, energy efficiency, ICT, innovative technologies, security, intermodality, green logistics, sustainability, wider regional development, knowledge ...

2014 – 2020

=> No cohesion funding; **14 new projects;**

approx. **<u>11,6 mio €</u> funds approved** (for activities of 45,2 mio €) / 6 different programs
