- An action to **"secure the commitment** of at least half of Union Member States" to be considered an "ERA action" Setting-up of the new ERA






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Towards the ERA Policy Agenda 2025-27: Process



Implementation and priorities: Priorities & key deliverables for the coming months

Strengthen Research Careers - Action 4

- Adoption of proposal to Council Recommendation on European Framework for Research Careers
- Launch of implementation tools: ERA Talent Platform (EUR 2.5 million) Research & Innovation Careers Observatory– (RICO) (EUR 3.7 million in the next two years).
- Exchange of best practices on skills (ERA4You, ResearchCOMP)
- Promote the concept of a political partnership on young researchers with the launch of a Horizon Europe Pilot Call in 2024





Research assessment- Action 3

- 'Coalition for Advancing Research Assessment', CoARA, was constituted in December 2022 with 344 participants and has started its work
- First analysis of legal and administrative barriers as well as national workshops



Implementation and priorities: Priorities & key deliverables for the coming months

ERA Pilot for Green Hydrogen - Action 11.1

- Establish the Roadmap on hydrogen valleys (in June 2023)
- Double the number of valleys by 2025 (with an additional EUR 200 million from Horizon Europe);
- Create synergies within the SET Plan framework (Action 11.2)
- Develop further skills on hydrogen





Access to Excellence - Action 16

- Set up strategic partnerships with MS through Enhanced Dialogues;
- Bring together R&I policy actors and managing authorities to assess the innovation divide, increase excellence, capitalise as much as possible the widening instruments, promote reforms and leverage R&D investments through synergies



Implementation and priorities: Other actions of high political interest

Open Science - Action 1

- Development of EOSC thematic demonstrators to showcase EOSC added value, such as the Covid-19 data platform and the platform for marine data;
- Establishment of Monitoring mechanism an catalogue of best practices;
- Development of sustainability options for EOSC post-2027.



Research Infrastructures - Action 8

 Prepare next investment agenda through a set of activities for European Research Infrastructures, including the new ESFRI Roadmap cycle.

Academic Freedom - Action 6


- Development of a monitoring system for academic freedom and freedom of scientific research;
- Exploration of options for legislative framework, building on SWD on tackling R&I foreign interference.



Citizen Science - Action 14

- Finalized pilot on Plastic Pirates led by DE;
- Endorse the idea of a Network of European Cities of Science, building on Leiden European City of Science, EU Contest for Young Scientists and EU TALENTON.





Latest developments:

- Future improvements of Scoreboard/ Dashboard (indicators, linkages to action-related monitoring)
- Consortium for ERA monitoring started its work in January 2023.
- IT development team established to provide visualized data on the future ERA Policy Platform.

Coming up:

• First EU-level report to be published in autumn 2023, other monitoring products by end-2023.
