Our expertise:

We are a multidisciplinary research group with expertise on <u>social, technological and</u> <u>economic aspects of circular transitions.</u> We aim to develop inclusive societal innovations that stimulate circular transitions through boundary work.

- **Economic** (incentivation circular value networks, sustainable business model innovation & experimentation)
- **Social** (innovation acceptance, behavioral change-awareness, -irrational- decision making, nudging-, circular consumption, co-creation, design thinking)
- **Technology** (sustainability assessment, biomimicry, addressing technology-implementation gap) Community coins, Circular business model experimentation (Circular X Maastricht University), Research project 'circular entrepreneurship' with 15 SME companies

<u>Our contribution:</u> our expertise and twin circular territorial clusters <u>coupling</u> (<u>social</u>) <u>design</u> <u>with high-tech:</u>

- 1. Urban Brainport region: Glocal high-tech, raw critical materials, praised for its innovation, dense network with triple helix partners (from which our research group emerged), strong design sector, social inclusiveness under pressure -> Circularity not on top of mind
- 2. Urban Dortmund Lünen region: transition from fossil fuel based- to high-tech. Cooperation agreement established.

Ambitions:

- To spark circular awareness and behavioral change processes among high-tech companies and their supporting regional value network (incl. citizens, communities, nontraditional partners) to create circular production & consumption processes
- To develop a multidisciplinary approach for just societal innovations, integrating technological, ecological, economic and social innovation

Wanted partners:

- Partners with complementary expertise to ours, e.g. blockchain, urban development, ecology
- Other regions to compare solutions for different socio-economic environments
- Public-private partnership models, interregional cooperation mechanisms and participatory methods (e.g. reflexive monitoring)
