


What is the CETP?

- The planned Clean Energy Transition Partnership (CETP) is a multilateral and strategic partnership of national and regional RDI programmes in European Member States and Associated Countries in Horizon Europe.
- The CETP addresses the challenge of clean energy transition through coordinating national and regional research, development and innovation strategies, programmes, activities and stakeholders.
- The CETP benefits from the experience of 14 successful ERA-Nets in Horizon 2020.
- In November 2020, the Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) has been approved by 32 countries and regions.

CETP SRIA Challenges




From Challenges to Transition Initiatives (TRIs)


