








Principles

- Collaborative and cross-border projects
- Integrated research and development windows but one programme
- Important for EDF to be inclusive
- Support to innvation capacity
- Demand is driven by Member States
- Take into account security interests
- Compliance with ethical principles









Eligible entities


- Consortium of at least three legal entities established in at least three different Member
 States/Associated Countries (Norway through the EEA agreement)
- Only entities established in the Union or in Norway which are not controlled by third countries/companies
- Exception if conditions relating to the security and defence interests of the Union and its Member States are met:
 - No risk in the ability to perform the action (security of supply)
 - Sensitive information are not accessible to 3rd country entity (security of information)
 - No Transfer of IP (IPR remains in the EU)
 - Guarantees approved by Member States needed
- Companies outside the Union can cooperate (conditions above apply), but without EU funding







Inclusion of SMEs in EDF

- SME bonus & award criterion
- Open calls dedicated to SMEs
- Connecting SMEs with wider defence community
 - EDIDP 2019 outcome shows that 37% of entities in projects were SMEs
 - 25% of these SMEs in SME call, 75% in other calls

 - supporting defencerelated SMEs


